PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

VENUE

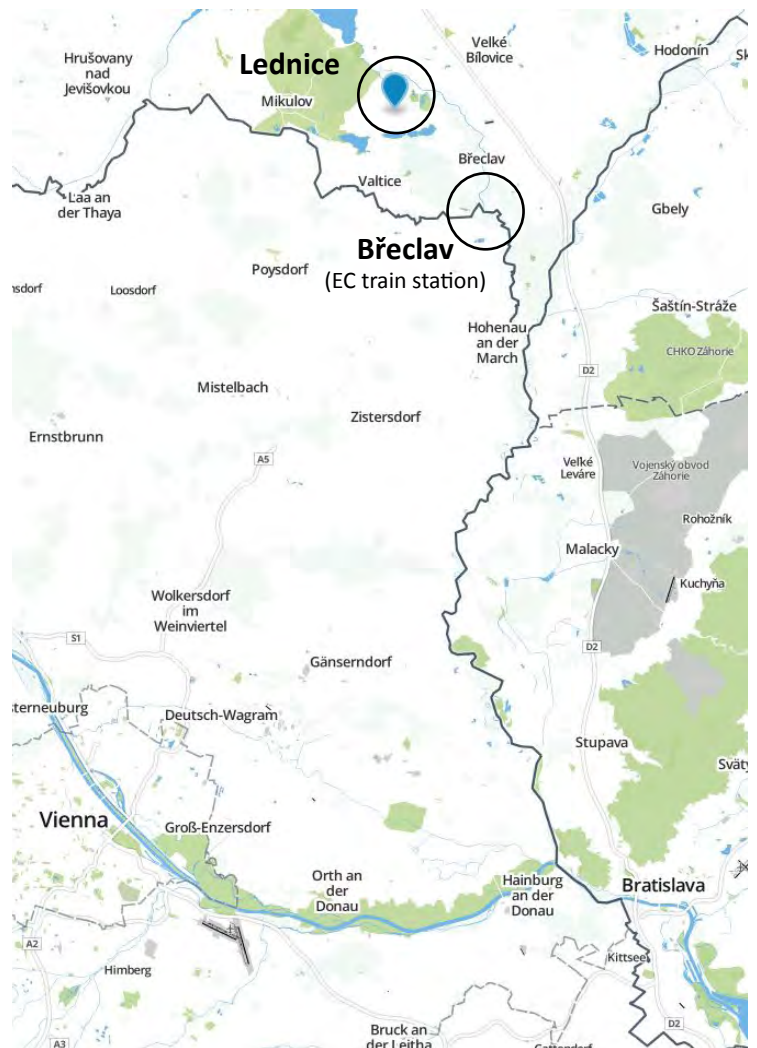
Lednice is a small town (2000 inhabitants) in South Moravia in the eastern part of the Czech Republic near to the Austrian borders, however the castle and landscape park makes it one of the most visited places in Czech Republic. Lednice gained its importance in 18th century, when it became the summer residence of Liechteistein family and since the end of 19th century has been the centre of Czech gardening and garden design. This tradition continues with the Faculty of Horticulture of Mendel University, which has its campus situated in western part of town. The conference takes place in reconstructed horse stables, which are part of Lednice castle.



TRANSPORT

The nearest airport is Vienna Schwechat (aprox. 100km from Lednice). Take bus No. 1187 from platform 7 to Wien Dorfelstrasse (Meidling Bahnhof), which leaves every half an hour. From Wien Meidling take EC train to Breclav (the first station behind borders), which leaves every two hours. Please note, that Wien Meidling is a temporary station for international trains, since the main international trainstation recently under construction. We recommend to order tickets online via www.oebb.at/en.

Please note, that the last train from Wien Meidling leaves at 22.31. PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

FEES

We do not charge entrance fee, although we must charge fee for meals and social evening (36€). This fee will be paid on site.

DISCUSSION PANELS

The structure of the panel is following: each panellists has 10 minutes to present topic, 1 hour discussion follows afterwards. Presentations and discussion will be held in English or Czech, translated simultaneously. All participants included to the discussion panel should send a presentation one week prior to the conference (21st May 2014). POSTER SESSION

All posters will be presented during the entire conference, however, on Thursday from 17:30 till 19:30 a special time slot will be dedicated to highlight the posters and have a more open discussion on the posters. Poster template is available under this [link](#) as a pdf or Adobe Indesign 5 file format. Poster dimesions are 70 cm width and 100 cm height. Poster printing is not arranged by organisers.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Accommodation is booked by organisers for registered participants until 31st of March in Hotel Miroslava Lednice. Participants registered after this date should book accommodation by themselves. Please refer to [booking.com](#) for other options or ask organisers for recommendation.

The costs of catering on the whole conference are 36 € (the price includes per day: 2 x coffeebreak: coffee, tea, cake / sandwich, 1 x lunch; and social evening with dinner on Thursday 29th).

YOU MAY WANT TO KNOW

- Currency which is used in the Czech Republic is Czech crown (CZK). The actual rate is approximatly 27,5 Crowns for Euro.
- Lednice is known for its warm climate. The average temperature in May is 15 °C , although during hot days may rise to 30 °C.
- The region is also famous for its wine production. Valtice - the “wine capital” is situated 7km away from Lednice.
- The region was Liechtenstein’s manor from 16th century until beginning of 20th century. The Liechtenstein family created a unique designed landscape in this area, with many of monuments and sights.
- The venue of the conference are former baroque horses stables, created in 18th century by J.B. Fischer von Erlach, an important artist of that era.

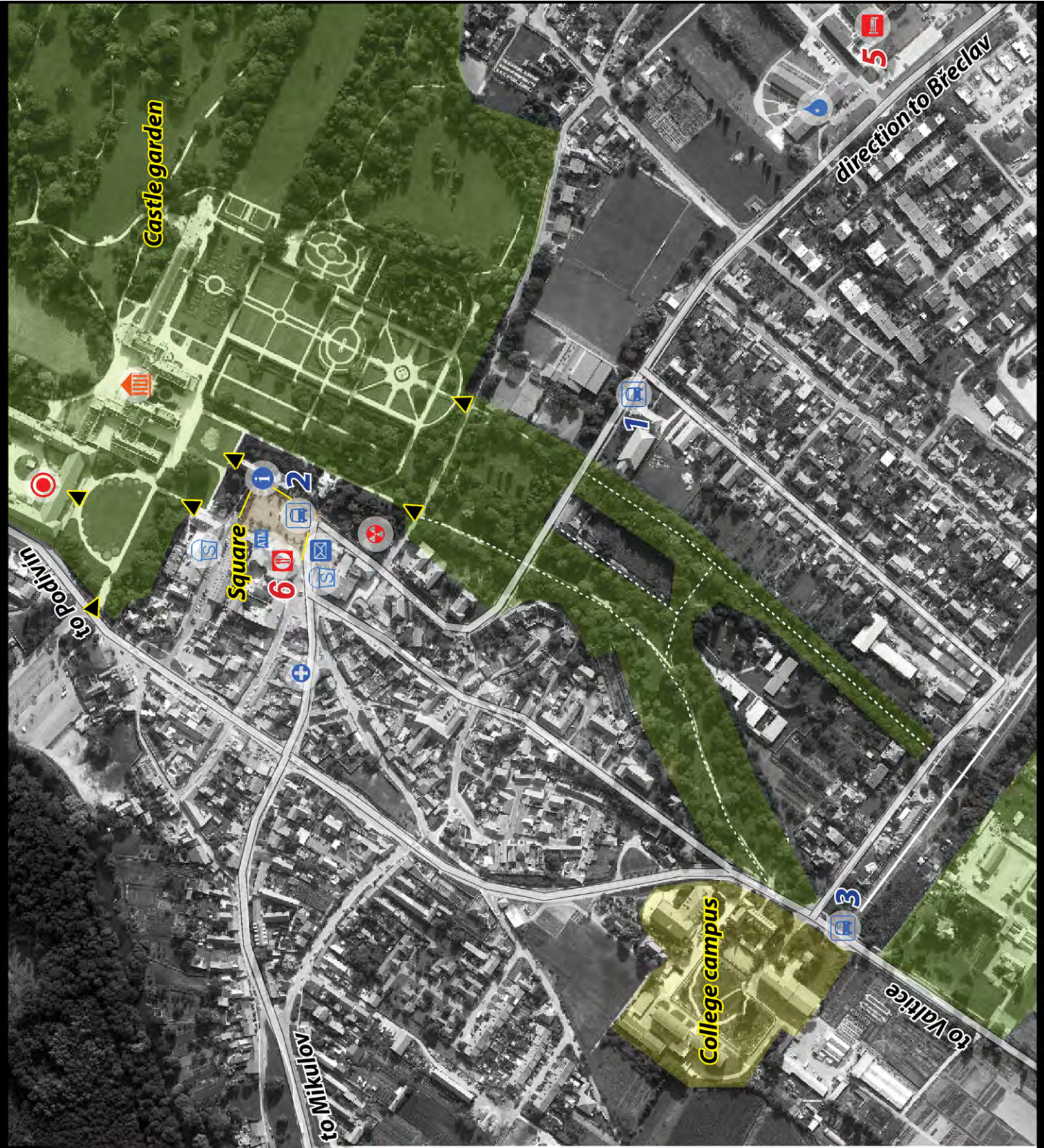
