## Election of President and Vice-Presidents 2016

Since in 2016 the term of the President and Vice-Presidents is ending, the UNISCAPE General Assembly of Galway on 29<sup>th</sup> June needs to (re)elect its President and Vice-Presidents. Therefore, candidates are being invited to make themselves known to any of the members of the Executive Board, or to our Office Manager Tommaso Zanaica.

# **Profile President and Vice-Presidents**

According to article 7 of the UNISCAPE statute (see UNISCAPE website, under *Documents*):

#### Art. 7 - General Assembly

- The General Assembly shall represent the decision-making body of UNISCAPE. It shall be composed of representatives appointed by the single Members. Observers may participate to the General Assembly meetings without voting rights.
- The General Assembly shall elect a UNISCAPE President and two Vice-Presidents from amongst its members for a term of four years. Candidates may be re-elected for the duration of one further term. Meetings of the General Assembly shall be chaired by the President of UNI-SCAPE or, in his/her absence, by one of the two Vice-Presidents.

The UNISCAPE Presidents are not remunerated.

It is the Executive Board's intention to propose a further definition of the competences and responsibilities of a Daily Management Board, which will consist of the Presidents and the Director.

## **Procedure**

To guarantee a transparent procedure, candidates are invited to make themselves known with a short curriculum and vision statement (one page max.) ultimately 1 week before the GA (22 June 2016), so that the candidacy can be announced timely to the UNISCAPE members. Voting will take place by secret ballots, unless the GA unanimously decides to (re)elect by acclamation. Each UNISCAPE member can take a maximum of three proxies of members who are unable to attend the GA.
