Moreover, at the beginning of 2018, UNISCASPE should also celebrate 10 years from the final constitutive act, signed in Florence on 19th of January-2008. A Seminar could be organized, consisting in the presentation of a selection of publications on landscape topics, written and edited by young researchers; jointly the results of the Peoples Landscapes Video Contest could be presented.

2020

In 2020 two special events are planned:

-*Florence 2020*: the Management Committee is in charge to prepare a proposal for an International Conference celebrating the twenty years since the ELC was signed in Florence. The idea is to make an evaluation of the critical aspects of the ELC implementation as well as to recognize the accomplishments during these 20 years. An appropriate date could be on 20th October (proposed as European day of the Landscape at the 9.CoE. Conference in Strasbourg).

- *Architecture Biennial in Venice*. The aim is to work to introduce for the first time Landscape as a topic within the Biennial frame. This would include the possibility to participate as an active part of Biennial (from May until November).
