For the first time the seat of the International Congress represents small islands, one of the characteristics of heroic viticulture. The archipelago of the Canaries is formed by seven islands with unique characteristics in the world, not only for the vineyards situated until 1700 meters above the sea level or in slopes of over 30% or terraces, but also for the high biodiversity level and for the presence of autochthone vines all on foot, since phylloxera didn't reach these places. Unique territories, some of which have been declared Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO, that have given place to landscapes of extraordinary beauty and great value.

Abstract acceptance and instructions for the oral or poster presentation will be notified from 15th January 2018.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts must be written in English or in Spanish.

ALL ABSTRACTS MUST CONTAIN:

- I. A concise title describing the subject matter;*
- II. Name(s) of the author(s) preceded by the initials (no title(s));*
- III. Postal and email addresses;*
- IV. A description of the purpose of the study (introduction);*
- V. A brief description of the fundamental methods used;*
- VI. A description of the results presented in sufficient detail to support the conclusions;*
- VII. Conclusions.*

Note: Abstracts will be published as they are received, without correcting typing errors or any other mistakes made by the authors.



EDITORIAL RULES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The length must not exceed one page: A4 paper format; written in 12-point Times New Roman font, using 1.5 line-spacing and with margins set to 3cm.

- I. Use Times New Roman typeface only and simple fonts, align text vertically (except for Latin words) and avoid all font size variations and the underlying format (except to indicate Latin words);*
- II. Do not exceed 2,000 characters per language (including title, authors, text and the space between title, authors and text);*
- III. Use bold fonts for the names of the authors;*
- IV. The address of each author must be listed according to the following examples:*
